The Alchemist: VISUAL PROJECT

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this assignment is for you to apply thematic ideas from a work of fiction to

both a visual and written product that will be presented to the class in a gallery

setting.

Method: You will achieve this purpose by creating a visual project based on The Alchemist and

composing an accompanying artist's statement.

<u>Details</u>: This assignment is due January 15th or 19th depending on your class day, and is worth 40

points. No late slips allowed.

Procedure:

Consider the many thematic ideas present in *The Alchemist*. Choose one of these ideas.
 How is this idea expressed in the text? What is the significance of this thematic idea to the text?

- Then choose an excerpt directly from the book that encapsulates the thematic idea you
 have chosen. This excerpt must be incorporated into the visual portion of your project.
- Illustrate your excerpt in two or three dimensions, so that your thematic idea and excerpt are clear to your audience. Remember that your excerpt must be incorporated into this portion of the product. Be creative in your illustration. You may use paint, yarn, paper...
- Next, you will write an artist's statement that functions as your analysis of how the
 thematic idea, excerpt, and visual tie together. Your artist's statement must also discuss
 how you see this piece connecting to you. This paragraph must be a final, polished draft
 that is error free in IEC format. In addition, this must be double spaced and typed in 12point plain font.
- You will be graded on originality and depth of thought. You will be required to show this
 project to the class accompanied by your artist's statement. All projects will be set up
 on the desks and we will have a gallery walk/ viewing party on the due date.
- Your final product will be a stunningly professional visual (20 points) with an exceptionally well written artist's statement (20 points) to place beside the visual.
