- 5. Bring the bag to school to share, filled with your items; beware valuable items!
- 6. Write a separate explanation, in complete sentences, that explains each item, and how it represents you literally and/or symbolically in the correlating category below. You must have a minimum of two items that can be related to symbolically. This explanation is what you will read aloud to the class as you present your items.
- 7. The bag will be shared to the whole class, and explanation read. Then you will take home the items and turn in the writing.

- 1. A hobby or free-time activity that you enjoy
- 2. One of your favorites (food, color, music, book, celebrity, etc.)
- 3. Future plans or goals
- 4. Something you would like to do better
- 5. A place you would like to visit
- 6. Something special about your family
- 7. The best part of summer vacation
- 8. A memorable event or time in your life
- 9. Something that you really dislike
- 10. A talent or special ability you have
- 11. Something to represent a part of your personality
- 12. What you find funny or laugh about often
