## FRANKENSTEIN ANALYSIS

- <u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this assignment is for you to begin the process of literary critique.
- <u>Method</u>: You will achieve this purpose by analyzing a piece of writing about another piece of writing... Namely, an article about *Frankenstein*.
- <u>Details</u>: This assignment is due at the end of class today, and is worth 30 points.

## Procedure:

- 1. Read the assigned text: "Forward: The Future of Frankenstein," by Walter James Miller, Professor of English School of Professional and Continuing Studies at New York University.
- 2. Annotate this article looking for the *different topics* within the body of the article, and how each of these topics *could possibly connect with the modern world* that we live in today. **This portion of the assignment is worth 15-points.**

## You must use your own paper to complete this portion of the assignment that is worth 15-points.

- 3. On your own paper, summarize each section. Be brief and to the point.
- 4. Which one of these topics do you find to be most interesting? Why?
- 5. Write a detailed paragraph with a clear topic sentence (inference) that is fully supported by well-blended specific textual evidence. Finally, write strong commentary that analyzes how this topic connects with a real world idea that you feel especially passionate about.
- 6. Staple your answers and this sheet to the annotated article and turn into the basket at the end of class today.
