## Irony Cartoon

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this assignment is for you to practice visual analysis of irony.

<u>Method</u>: You will achieve this purpose by creating a comic strip that relates to anything from English I Pre-AP.

<u>Details</u>: This assignment is due at the beginning of class on Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup> for "A" day or Thursday, January 21<sup>st</sup> for "B" day, and is worth 20 points.

## Procedure:

- 1. Choose one of the three types of irony in the notes handout on the back of this sheet
  - a. Save this for your reference.
- 2. Create a single comic strip of 1-5 frames that accurately portrays your choice of irony.
  - a. It should be no larger than a sheet of printer paper.
- 3. Your cartoon may visually depict the type of irony that you have chosen, or you may use text to convey your meaning, but <u>it must relate to something</u> we have done or discussed in class this year.
- 4. Whether you visually or textually represent the irony within your cartoon strip, you must label the type of irony that you have chosen and explain why the situation is ironic.
- 5. Your grade will be based on accuracy and visual aesthetics and clarity in the explanation. Make sure to label the type of irony and proofread it all!
