Homeric Similes

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this assignment is for you to gain experience analyzing Homeric Similes and properly blending quotes.

<u>Method</u>: You will achieve this purpose by analyzing Homeric Similes and properly blending quotes within your analysis of those similes.

<u>Details</u>: This assignment is due at the end of class and is worth 27-points.

Procedure:

- 1. Choose three Homeric Similes from within the *Odyssey*.
- 2. Each Homeric simile must use a different quote blending strategy.
- 3. You must use direct excerpts from the Homeric Similes.
- 4. You must use Book and line numbers for your citations.
- 5. All answers must be in complete sentences.
